SIGNIFICANT CONTRIBUTION

Work closely with Sales and Marketing team to develop the short and long term demand forecasting specially for import product in order to improve the forecast accuracy and proper availability of stock.

High inventory was leading to working capital and warehouse cost issue. Analyzed stocks for slow and non-movers and reduced inventory by 30% leading to cost reduction by 20%+.

High cost of warehouse addressed by implementing direct transportation from factory to customer bypassing warehouse and simplifying transportation resulting in savings of 10% pa.

Executed the Dispatch Plan (PDP) for full truck load by clubbing the order of customer in a particular route which result in fast delivery an reduce the cost by almost 10% in transportation
